Museums / Galleries / Art associations April 1, 2023 / 7pm - midnight

Opening / from 6pm at the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden.

At this popular cultural event on Saturday, April 1, 2023, numerous museums, galleries and project spaces will once again open their doors and offer a diverse program from 7pm until midnight. The "Short Night" is a cultural event that has become an integral part of the Wiesbaden event calendar: with its exciting and multifaceted programme, it attracts thousands of visitors from near and far to the state capital every year. This year new exhibitors are taking part and the "Short Night" has reached a record number of 31 participating museums, art associations, project spaces and galleries.

In addition, the Wiesbaden **PopJazzChoir** and the **Rolling Museum**, in which one hundred classic car owners from Hesse, Rhineland-Palatinate, Baden Württemberg and Bavaria have confirmed their participation, are once again taking part. The **"Short Night"** is thus not only one of the oldest museum nights in Germany, but also an unmissable cultural event for Wiesbaden every spring, as well as beyond the region.

The event attracts many thousands of visitors from the Rhine-Main region to the state capital with an exciting and multifaceted program and is an ambassador for the city's high cultural standards. This year we are pleased to welcome six new exhibitors. They are the artroom Wiesbaden in Eltviller Str. 6, where under the title "CROSSWORLD_PUZZLE" a group exhibition with ceramic sculptures by students of the Hochschule für Gestaltung Offenbach and its head of the laboratory art, Merja Herzog-Hellstén, will be shown. The Künstlerhaus 43 in the former Palasthotel at Kochbrunnenplatz 1 presents the painter Shabnam Miller. At KunstKontor at Taunusstraße 55, the group exhibition "Mixed Media" will be on display, featuring, among others, Stefanie Minzenmay and Rolf Gith who explore the theme of materiality. Also premiering are the Galerie Neongolden at Kleine Schwalbacher Str. 8 with photographs by Marc Peschke and woodcuts by Roman Klonek, the Queere Zentrum e.V. Wiesbaden, Bornhofenweg 7a with works by Sanja Praktisch, and the Kunstverein Walkmühle, Bornhofenweg 9, where 26 artists will deal with the extraordinarily exciting, because topical, theme "ANGST - Krisenindikator oder Überlebenstrieb".

A special highlight are the exhibitions of **Annika Kahrs** from Hamburg and Cemile Sahin, born in Wiesbaden, at the **Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden**, **center for contemporary art**. The performances, videos, sound installations and objects of Annika Kahrs show the importance that music and sound – i.e. acoustic information – play in different social, cultural and political structures, while the focus of the artistic work of Wiesbaden-born Cemile Sahin is on political events and their narration, which she remarkably combines in installation, film, sculpture, text, sound and photography.



At 6pm the twenty-first edition of the "Short Night" will be opened by city councillor **Axel Imholz**, head of the culture department of the city Wiesbaden, by the organizer of the event Erhard Witzel, as well as by the artistic director of the art association **Elke Gruhn** in the Nassauischer Kunstverein in the Wilhelmstr. 15. The **string quartet Oxalis** with **Stefan Besan**, violin I, **Friederike Kampick**, violin II, **Tim Düllberg**, viola and **Lucija Rupert**, violoncello, will musically accompany the opening.

Unforgettable for all guests present will be the performance "Strings" by Annika Kahrs.

From 7m until midnight, the participating 31 institutions and galleries look forward to welcoming visitors with a traditionally free admission.


