# Kunstverein 3D / Virtual exhibition visits at Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden

During the pandemic, the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden has been exploring new virtual ways and has digitized the entire place as well as some of the past exhibitions as a 3D-modell in cooperation with the New York- based company *Walter's Cube*. This way, visitors can experience the exhibitions retrospectively. Further projects in these virtual rooms are planned for the future.

Since the beginning of the pandemic in early 2020, the Nassauischer Kunstverein had to remain closed for more than 250 days. Thus, exhibitions that took place during that time could either be visited only for a very short period or not at all. Now, visitors have the chance to experience some of the exhibitions they have missed in a digital 3D-modell of the Kunstverein – a space that is opened non-stop, regardless of travel restrictions or the closing of Nassauischer Kunstverein due to the installation of an elevator in 2022.

In cooperation with the New York-based company Walter's Cube, who has already digitized Hamburger Bahnhof in Berlin or the Guggenheim Museum in New York, the Kunstverein has been digitally reconstructed as an Online Viewing Room and is accessible on the website of the Nassauischer Kunstverein Wiesbaden:
